Our Disability Guide is a helpful resource to assist in planning your day and making informed decisions about the various attractions, rides, services and amenities in our Park. If you need additional assistance, please feel free to ask any Team Member. We proudly offer a wholesome, family-fun environment for our Guests, and we are here to help Create Memories Worth Repeating™ for you and your family.

Our Guide Map is available inside the Park turnstiles and includes a layout of the Park. The day's show schedule is also available.

To maintain the Park's family atmosphere, we ask that all Guests be courteous to other visitors and Team Members. Please abide by all safety information posted throughout the Park or provided by our Team Members.

Thank you for your consideration and enjoy your day at Wild Adventures.

TICKETS

At the Front Gate, you will find clearly marked disability accessible windows for purchasing admission tickets and Season Passes. Regular admission and Season Pass prices apply. (Prices are subject to change without notice.)

GUEST RELATIONS

Guest Services is located to the left of the turnstiles and provides a variety of services and information about Park amenities and services.

ACCESSIBILITY

Most of Wild Adventures is accessible to our Guests with disabilities. A ride admission sheet is required to access rides or attractions through the exit. Please visit Guest Relations or First Aid to discuss your specific access needs.

General Information

FIRST AID

Wild Adventures has two First Aid offices: one near Dockside Restaurant and one in Splash Island Water Park near the restrooms. Both First Aid locations are staffed with certified EMTs and paramedics. If you should have a medical emergency, please contact the nearest Team Member who will notify First Aid to respond. Guests bringing medications that must be refrigerated and/or extra oxygen bottles may leave these items in any First Aid Office. Please clearly label medications and other personal belongings with the responsible party's name, address, phone number and the date. ID is required to retrieve items.

WHEELCHAIR & ECV RENTAL

Wheelchairs and Electric Convenience Vehicles (ECVs) are available daily for rent on a first-come, first-served basis. Wheelchairs are \$10 per day. ECVs are \$34 per day. A security deposit is required. Operator training is required for ECVs. Prices are subject to change without notice. Wheelchairs and ECVs may be rented and returned at Kids Gone Wild located inside the park across from the turnstiles.

Please note: All Guests using wheelchairs and ECVs, whether personal or rented at Wild Adventures, must follow all manufacturer's operating guidelines and Park rules. Park rules are available at Kids Gone Wild for Guests bringing their own wheelchairs or ECVs. Wild Adventures also reserves the right to deny entry to any ECV or wheelchair deemed unsafe for use on Park near other Guests. Only one Guest per ECV or wheelchair. No passenger carriers and/or trailers of any type may be attached to ECVs. Guests must be 16 or older to rent an ECV in the Park. The Guest using the ECV must rent the ECV.

If walking or standing present physical challenges, we strongly recommend the use of a wheelchair or ECV to navigate Wild Adventures. Please remember that the distance between various Park buildings and attractions is much greater than any wait in line.

COMPANION-ASSISTED RESTROOMS

For our Guests' convenience, we offer disability accessible, Companion-Assisted Restrooms located at First Aid Stations in Wild Adventures and Splash Island.

COMPANION ASSISTANCE

Due to the nature and layout of our Park, Wild Adventures recommends that anyone legally blind or who has vision

impairments to enjoy the Park with a companion. Please ask any Team Member if you have further questions.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Service animals are welcome in most locations throughout Wild Adventures. Animals must be in the owner's control and under control at all times. Service animals must be on a harness or leash no longer than four feet. Owners are responsible for cleaning and disposing of any animal waste.

Service animals are not allowed on rides or attractions. If you wish to ride, we suggest a companion visit the Park with you to care for your service animal. Service animals must not be left unattended or with Team Members.

Due to the live animals used in some shows, we ask that any service animal remain out of view as to not distract the tigers and other animals and for the safety of our staff. Wild Adventures reserves the right to deny access to a service animal when safety is in question.

THEATERS

For the convenience of Guests using wheelchairs or ECVs, early entry is available before doors open for general seating. Doors open at least 15 minutes prior to showtimes. The theater is equipped to provide one (1) companion seat at every wheelchair/ECV space. Due to the layout and capacity of each theater, larger groups accompanying a Guest in a wheelchair or ECV may have to separate. Ushers are available to assist with wheelchair/ECV parking and seating. For additional assistance, please contact any Theater Usher or Team Member.

Due to Georgia State Fire Codes, Guests using ECVs or wheelchairs may not park in any theater aisle or row. Seating is limited in all theaters and is filled on a first-come, first-serve basis.

All outdoor theaters are accessible to Guests with disabilities. All safety guidelines and fire codes for indoor theaters also apply to outdoor venues. If you have any questions, please notify a sound technician in the back of the theater or any other Team Member.

Show Scripts: Wild Adventures regular season show scripts are available for use during the show and must be returned at the end of the performance. Please see a Theater Usher for assistance. Scripts are also available on the Safari Train.

General Information

SMOKING

Smoking at Wild Adventures is permitted only in designated smoking areas marked by a yellow umbrella.

SHOPS & RESTAURANTS

Wild Adventures shops and restaurants are accessible to Guests with disabilities. Please ask any Team Member if you need assistance reaching items or have special dietary needs.

COMPLIMENTARY ICE WATER

Most Wild Adventures food/concession locations that serve fountain drinks also offer complimentary cups of ice water.

DISABILITY PARKING

The main parking area and van accessible spaces for Guests with disabilities are located in the disability parking area adjacent to the Park entrance. Upon arrival at Wild Adventures please advise the Toll Booth Team Members that you need disability parking, and they will direct you to the disability lot or the Guest Drop Off & Pickup Area. Disabled parking is filled on a first-come, first-serve basis and may reach capacity early on some days. If the disability parking area is unavailable, the Guest Drop Off & Pickup Area adjacent to the Park entrance may be utilized for ease of dropping off and picking up Guests with disabilities. Standard vehicle and RV parking fees apply unless Guest is a Gold Season Passholder.

All vehicles parked in a marked disabled parking space must have a government-issued license plate or displayed disabled parking tag. Without proper permits, violators may be subject to fines issued by the Lowndes County Sheriff's Department and/or towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense.

GUEST DROP OFF & PICKUP AREA

For our Guests' convenience, we provide a Guest Drop Off & Pickup Area located at the Park's front gate entrance. Instead of boarding a tram, Guests using wheelchairs as well as those using ECVs may use this location to access or leave the Park.

Service animals are allowed on trams as long as they meet guidelines outlined in the Service Animals section of this brochure.

Ride Guidelines & Rules

AMUSEMENTS & GAMES

All amusements and games are accessible to Guests with disabilities. All amusements and games require an additional fee and are not included in Park admission.

MEDICAL RESTRICTIONS

All Ride Safety Information is posted at each ride entrance so that you may make informed decisions on your ability to safely participate. This brochure describes the ride's movements and forces while the ride safety signs include medical restrictions and special safety instructions.

Remember: Wild Adventures does not know your medical history or restrictions. Please review all safety information prior to boarding. Please be aware of all medical and height restrictions. We also encourage you to watch the ride or attraction prior to choosing to ride. If in doubt, do not ride.

FOOD & DRINK

You may finish food and drinks while waiting in line. However, eating, drinking or chewing gum or candy while riding is prohibited.

BOARDING A RIDE OR ATTRACTION

Guests using wheelchairs or ECVs or those with other disabilities may use the marked disability entrances to gain access to the ride or attraction. A ride admission sheet is required to access rides or attractions through the exit. These entrances are designed to provide access to the ride, not to expedite your wait. You may have to wait once reaching the loading area. If you need assistance transferring from your ECV or wheelchair, you must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions; however, they are not trained to assist you in transferring to and from a ride vehicle and will not be able to do so.

RESTRAINT SYSTEMS

Guests must fit properly into all ride restraint systems to participate. All rides and attractions at Wild Adventures are designed for persons with average body stature and proportion. Some ride restraint systems may not accommodate Guests of larger weight and/or greater height.

For the safety of Guests nearby, those wearing casts, braces or prostheses may be unable to ride if the restraint cannot be properly secured.

Ride Guidelines & Rules

SECURING LOOSE ITEMS

Glass items, game prizes, umbrellas, canes, crutches, caps, glasses, cameras and other loose items must be left with a non-riding member of your party or stored in a Park rental locker or your personal vehicle. Some rides provide shelves or bins to store these items while riding; however, Wild Adventures is not responsible for items damaged, lost or stolen during your ride experience.

LOOSE ARTICLES 1

No loose articles are permitted. All loose articles must be placed in the designated storage area or left with a non-rider. Cell phones, cameras, and video equipment are not permitted on the ride. Only those items secured in a pocket or a fanny pack around a rider's waist will be permitted provided it does not interfere with the ride's restraint(s). Riders wearing headwear for religious reasons may be asked to secure it to his/her head or shoulders, however, any heavy, large, or brimmed religious headwear is not permitted. Wearing your glasses or sunglasses is at your own risk. Wild Adventures is not responsible for articles that are lost, damaged or stolen.

LOOSE ARTICLES 2

All loose articles must be secured with a strap that sits across the chest during the ride. Purses and small bags secured around the rider's shoulder or waist are permitted provided they are closed and do not interfere with the ride's restraint(s). Cell phones, cameras, and video equipment must be secured and may not be used during the ride. Restricted articles must be placed in the designated storage area or left with a non-rider. Hats with brims (such as cowboy hats and boonie hats) and visors may not be worn and must be secured or left with a non-rider. Baseball style caps may be worn provided they are worn with the bill turned to the back of the head. Riders wearing headwear for religious reasons may be asked to secure it to his/her head or shoulders, however, any heavy, large, or brimmed religious headwear is not permitted. Wearing your glasses or sunglasses is at your own risk. Wild Adventures is not responsible for articles that are lost, damaged or stolen.

LOOSE ARTICLES 3

Loose articles are permitted on the ride provided they do not interfere with the safety restraint or cause hazard to the ride, other Guests or Team Members. Cell phones, cameras, and video equipment must be secured and may not be used during the ride. Restricted articles must be placed in the designated storage area or with a non-rider. Hats, caps and visors may be worn. Wearing your glasses or sunglasses is at your own risk. Wild Adventures is not responsible for articles that are lost, damaged or stolen.



LOOSE ARTICLES 4

Loose articles are permitted on the ride provided they do not interfere with the safety restraint or cause hazard to the ride, other Guests or Team Members. Riders should maintain control of loose articles at all times or place in provided storage area on the ride. Wild Adventures is not responsible for articles that are lost, damaged or stolen.

Remember: Ride Team Members are assigned and in place to ensure Guest safety and to operate the ride. Thus, they cannot be responsible for Guests' personal items. Park rental lockers are available for rent, and locations are indicated on the Park Guide Map by this symbol: 

Ride Guidelines & Rules

OXYGEN TANKS

Due to the forces, speeds and movements of our rides, oxygen tanks are not permitted on ride vehicles or boats. Oxygen tanks are allowed on the Safari Train and trams.

ARTIFICIAL LIMBS & AMPUTEES

On some rides, Guests who are amputees or those with artificial limbs may be unable to participate due to the inability to remain properly restrained during the ride or attraction. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding to ensure the safety of other Guests.

RIDE EVACUATIONS

Evacuations may be required in the unlikely event of mechanical difficulties or inclement weather. In the event of an evacuation, Guests may need to maneuver across catwalks and/or descend steep steps. Those unable to evacuate may need to wait, restrained in their seats, for further assistance to arrive.

SUPERVISING COMPANION

Each of our ride and attraction experiences are uniquely different. Ride admission requirements are determined by the ride dynamics, the ride restraints and manufacturer recommendations. Ride requirements, such as height, weight and supervising companion procedures apply to certain rides and attractions. Specific requirements for each ride and/or attraction can be found in the Accessibility Guide in the Rides and Attractions section.

A Supervising Companion is a responsible person who is at least 16 years of age and who meets all the rider requirements to ride alone.

Wild Adventures Symbols



This symbol indicates that Guests can remain in their wheelchairs or ECVs throughout the ride or attraction. It also identifies disability entrances throughout the Park.



This symbol indicates that Guests who use wheelchairs or ECVs must transfer from their vehicle to a ride vehicle to ride.



This symbol indicates that Guests using ECVs must transfer from their ECV to a wheelchair to participate in the attraction.



This symbol indicates that Guests who use wheelchairs or ECVs must be able to leave their vehicles and walk or be assisted by their companion to the ride entrance.



This symbol indicates that Guests must meet a minimum height requirement to ride.



GREEN CIRCLE indicates a Mild Thrill Attraction featuring low speeds with expected movements and anticipated thrills.



BLUE SQUARE indicates a Moderate Thrill Attraction featuring moderate speeds with unexpected movements and unusual and stressful Physical forces including but not limited to unanticipated thrills.



BLACK DIAMOND indicates a High Thrill Attraction featuring high speeds with extremely unusual and stressful Physical forces. This ride contains startling and unexpected thrills appropriate for only the most healthy and Physically able riders.

Ride Descriptions

ADVENTURE CAROUSEL



It doesn't matter what generation you grew up in - everyone can enjoy a relaxing ride on our 20-horse nostalgic Adventure Carousel. Each horse is crafted in turn-of-the-century style. The Adventure Carousel is beautiful to watch, with its brass pole ponies, chariots and glowing lights.

Ride Access

Guests using wheelchairs, and who otherwise meet the physical requirements to ride, must be able to transfer to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants are not trained to assist in transferring guests from their wheelchairs to a ride vehicle. Guests may need a companion's assistance during loading and unloading. Guests should enter through the exit.

Height Requirement

Guests must meet the following height/age requirements:

- Anyone below 36" must be accompanied by someone at least 16 years old. Guests must be below 52" to ride a horse.

Medical Recommendations

In addition to the requirements listed under General Information, guests with the following conditions should not ride:

- Surgery or Illness

Physical Requirements

To ride on a horse: Must have a minimum of at least one functioning arm and one functioning leg with sufficient lower body mass to straddle the horse to ride unaccompanied. Must have at least two functioning extremities.

To ride on a sleigh: Must be able to sit upright and maintain control of upper torso, head and neck if unaccompanied.

Guests wearing casts and/or prosthetic devices may ride permitted the cast and/or prosthetic device does not interfere with proper riding position.

Service Animals

Service animals are permitted on this attraction and must be in a sleigh or on the platform..

ADVENTURE GOLF (Pay Extra Attraction)



Take a break from the traditional fun of Wild Adventures and challenge yourself to 18 holes of Adventure Golf! This miniature golf course is fun for the entire family! Please note that not all holes are handicap accessible. Wheelchairs, carts, service dogs, etc... are permitted on the golf course. Guests may

leave wheelchairs, carts, etc... outside of the Safety Critical Area; however, ride personnel do not have the training required to Physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions only.

ADVENTURE QUEST RACEWAY (Pay Extra Attraction)

Feel the need for speed on a twisting track with hairpin turns and loads of fun. Gas powered go-karts take you up to speeds of 15-20 miles per hour and, of course, it's a race to the finish! The smaller racers can ride the junior track and play like the big kids!



Ride Access

Guests using wheelchairs, and who otherwise meet the physical requirements to ride, must be able to transfer to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants are not trained to assist in transferring guests from their wheelchairs to a ride vehicle. Guests may need a companion's assistance during loading and unloading. Guests should enter through the exit.

Height Requirement

Guests must meet the following height/age requirements:

- Kiddie Kart – Between 44" and 58" and between 5 and 10 years old to ride this attraction. Guests must not exceed 120lbs.
- Junior Kart – At least 46", 7 years of age or older, and must not exceed 200lbs.
- Single Kart – At least 58", 10 years of age or older, and must not exceed 300lbs.
- Double Kart – At least 58" and 10 years old to drive alone. At least 58" tall and 18 years old to drive with a passenger. Passenger must be at least 4 years old. Guests must not exceed 250lbs.

Medical Recommendations

In addition to the requirements listed under General Information, guests with the following conditions shall not ride:

- Pregnancy
- Heart Condition
- Back, Neck, or Bone Problems

Guests with the following conditions should not ride:

- Surgery or Illness

Physical Requirements

Driver: Must have a minimum of two functioning arms with the ability to grasp the steering wheel and two functioning legs with the

ability to control the foot pedals.

Passenger: Must have a minimum of at least one functioning arm and one functioning leg.

Guests wearing casts and/or prosthetic devices may ride permitted the cast and/or prosthetic device does not interfere with the restraint system and/or proper riding position.

Service Animals

Service Animals cannot be accommodated on the ride.

ANT FARM EXPRESS



Discover a great "in-between" coaster with the Ant Farm Express. Not too big and not too small, this coaster is just right to deliver gentle thrills for all ages.

Ride Access

Guests using wheelchairs, and who otherwise meet the physical requirements to ride, must be able to transfer to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants are not trained to assist in transferring guests from their wheelchairs to a ride vehicle. Guests may need a companion's assistance during loading and unloading. Guests should enter through the exit.

Height Requirement

Guests must meet the following height requirements:

- Guests must be 36" to ride this attraction.
- Guests between 36" and 44" must be accompanied by someone at least 16 years old.

Medical Recommendations

In addition to the requirements listed under General Information, guests with the following conditions shall not ride:

- Pregnancy
- Heart Condition
- Back, Neck, or Bone Problems

Guests with the following conditions should not ride:

- Surgery or Illness

Physical Requirements

Guests must have upper body control, and be able to sit up straight and hold head/neck up to ride. Guests must have one functioning arm and one functioning leg to ride.

Service Animals

Service Animals cannot be accommodated on the ride.

Ride Descriptions

AVIATOR



Try our swinging ride that is guaranteed to lift your spirits. The Aviator will lift you into the air with its 100-foot tall telescoping tower then spin cars round and round. The Aviator allows interactive rider controls to climb or dive. So while strapped into your seat, you can swing outward and feel the sensation of flight.

Ride Access

Guests using wheelchairs, and who otherwise meet the physical requirements to ride, must be able to transfer to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants are not trained to assist in transferring guests from their wheelchairs to a ride vehicle. Guests may need a companion's assistance during loading and unloading. Guests should enter through the exit.

Height/Weight Requirement

Guests must meet the following height/weight requirements:

- Guests must be 42" to ride this attraction.
- Guests between 42" & 48" must be accompanied by someone at least 16 years old.

Medical Recommendations

In addition to the requirements listed under General Information, guests with the following conditions shall not ride:

- Pregnancy
- Heart Condition
- Back, Neck, or Bone Problems
- Surgery or Illness

Physical Requirements

Guests must have upper body control, and be able to sit up straight and hold head/neck up to ride. Guests must have one functioning arm and two functioning extremities to ride. Guests must have sufficient lower extremity mass to ensure the ride restraint system functions properly.

Service Animals

Service Animals cannot be accommodated on the ride.

BEE BOP



It's a honey of a time for the little ones!

Bee Bop will take you on a twirling, whirling ride deep in the heart of Base Camp. Bee cars glide in a gentle circle as they weave up and down, reminiscent of the flight of a lazy bumblebee.

Ride Descriptions

Ride Access

Guests using wheelchairs, and who otherwise meet the physical requirements to ride, must be able to transfer to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants are not trained to assist in transferring guests from their wheelchairs to a ride vehicle. Guests may need a companion's assistance during loading and unloading. Guests should enter through the exit.

Height Requirement

Guests must meet the following height requirements:

- Guests must be 36" to ride this attraction alone.
- Guests below 36" must be accompanied by someone at least 16 years old.

Medical Recommendations

In addition to the requirements listed under General Information, guests with the following conditions should not ride:

- Surgery or Illness

Physical Requirements

Guests must have upper body control, and be able to sit up straight and hold head/neck up to ride. Guests must have one functioning arm or be accompanied by someone able to provide assistance and at least two functioning extremities to ride.

Service Animals

Service Animals cannot be accommodated on the ride.

BLACKFOOT FALLS



Saddle up for the wettest ride in the Wild West! Blackfoot Falls will send you splashing, drenching you with a tidal wave of fun. And don't for one minute think that the cowpokes standing off to the side miss out on the watery fun—you never know where that wave of water will fall.

Ride Access

Guests using wheelchairs, and who otherwise meet the physical requirements to ride, must be able to transfer to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants are not trained to assist in transferring guests from their wheelchairs to a ride vehicle. Guests may need a companion's assistance during loading and unloading. Guests should enter through the exit.

Height Requirement

Guests must meet the following height requirements:

- Guests must be 36" to ride this attraction.

Ride Descriptions

• Guests must between 36" and 42" must be accompanied by someone at least 16 years old.

Medical Recommendations

In addition to the requirements listed under General Information, guests with the following conditions shall not ride:

- Pregnancy
- Heart Condition
- Back, Neck, or Bone Problems

Guests with the following conditions should not ride:

- Surgery or Illness

Physical Requirements

Guests must have upper body control, and be able to sit up straight and hold head/neck up to ride. Guests must have one functioning arm and one functioning leg to ride.

Service Animals

BOOMERANG



This thrill ride, with its vertical loops, six inversions and two hills, is designed to take you on a 50-mph scream ride. The lift hill will pull the train backwards then watch out as it's released. The train will trek through a loop and a boomerang element before it travels up a second hill coming to a halt high in the air. Then brace yourself again because it's time to take the entire track in reverse.

Ride Access

Guests using wheelchairs, and who otherwise meet the physical requirements to ride, must be able to transfer to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants are not trained to assist in transferring guests from their wheelchairs to a ride vehicle. Guests may need a companion's assistance during loading and unloading. Guests should enter through the entrance.

Height Requirement

Guests must meet the following height requirements:

- Guests must be 48" to ride this attraction.

Medical Recommendations

In addition to the requirements listed under General Information, guests with the following conditions shall not ride:

- Pregnancy
- Heart Condition
- Back, Neck, or Bone Problems

Ride Descriptions

Guests with the following conditions should not ride:

- Surgery or Illness

Physical Requirements

Guests must have upper body control, and be able to sit up straight and hold head/neck up to ride. Guests must have one functioning arm and two functioning extremities to ride. Guests must have sufficient lower extremity mass to ensure the ride restraint system functions properly.

Service Animals

Service Animals cannot be accommodated on the ride.

CENTURY WHEEL



The beautiful eye catching "Century Wheel" brings back adult memories of the past, when Ferris wheels and fun parks were a time of peace and fun. For children, it's a chance to be lifted toward the sky and gives them a view of the surrounding landscape. The Century Wheel is fun for the entire family.

Ride Access

Guests using wheelchairs, and who otherwise meet the physical requirements to ride, must be able to transfer to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants are not trained to assist in transferring guests from their wheelchairs to a ride vehicle. Guests may need a companion's assistance during loading and unloading. Guests should enter through the exit.

Height Requirement

Guests must meet the following height/age requirements:

- Anyone below 42" must be accompanied by someone at least 16 years old.

Medical Recommendations

In addition to the requirements listed under General Information, guests with the following conditions shall not ride:

- Pregnancy
- Heart Condition
- Surgery or Illness

Physical Requirements

Guests must have upper body control, and be able to sit up straight and hold head/neck up to ride. Guests must have one functioning arm or be accompanied by someone able to provide assistance.

Service Animals

Service Animals cannot be accommodated on the ride.

Ride Descriptions

CHEETAH
