OVERVIEW

With an adventure for every family member, Wild Adventures (WA) is a theme, water and animal park rolled into one. The size of 155 football fields, it is the area's number one attraction. The park has the South's largest ride collection including major roller coasters, hundreds of animals and the region's largest water park. Open select days March through December, WA is located in Valdosta, Georgia.
